Charcoal from nearby trees, iron ore from the marshy Saugus River, and flux from the Nahant peninsula were dumped into the top of the furnace and heated.

The mill harnessed the water power of the Saugus River to fuel the furnace. The Europeans had to improvise, too. Lacking limestone for flux, the colonists mined gabbro instead to purify the ore. The 9-acre National Park is best seen with a tour guide who can explain the equipment and cool old tools, including a 500-pound hammer.
